The text of the abstract and the article is in English in MS WORD.

Page format: **A4 (210x148 mm), 25 mm margins** (top, bottom, left and right)

Font: **Times New Roman**, font size **11**

Line spacing: **regular**, text alignment: **justify**

Paper title – font size 14, bold, centered

Author name, author affiliation – under the paper title, font size 12, Italic bold, centered. In case of collective authorship, all authors must be stated.

Abstract

Abstract is written in English, maximum 250 characters.

The length of a contribution in prescribed format is 4-6 pages A4

Contacts

Author’s name, author’s address, author’s e-mail

Quotation and notes writing:

Literature quotation in the text: author’s surname or authors’ surnames, year of edition. If it is a literal quotation in inverted commas, page must be given as well; e.g. Carver, Scheier (1994), or „...“ (Carver, Scheier, 1994, 253). If there are 4 or more authors of the contribution, you must give surname of the first author and „et al.“, e.g. Vyrost et al., 1995

List of bibliography is given at the end of the contribution in alphabetical order of authors.

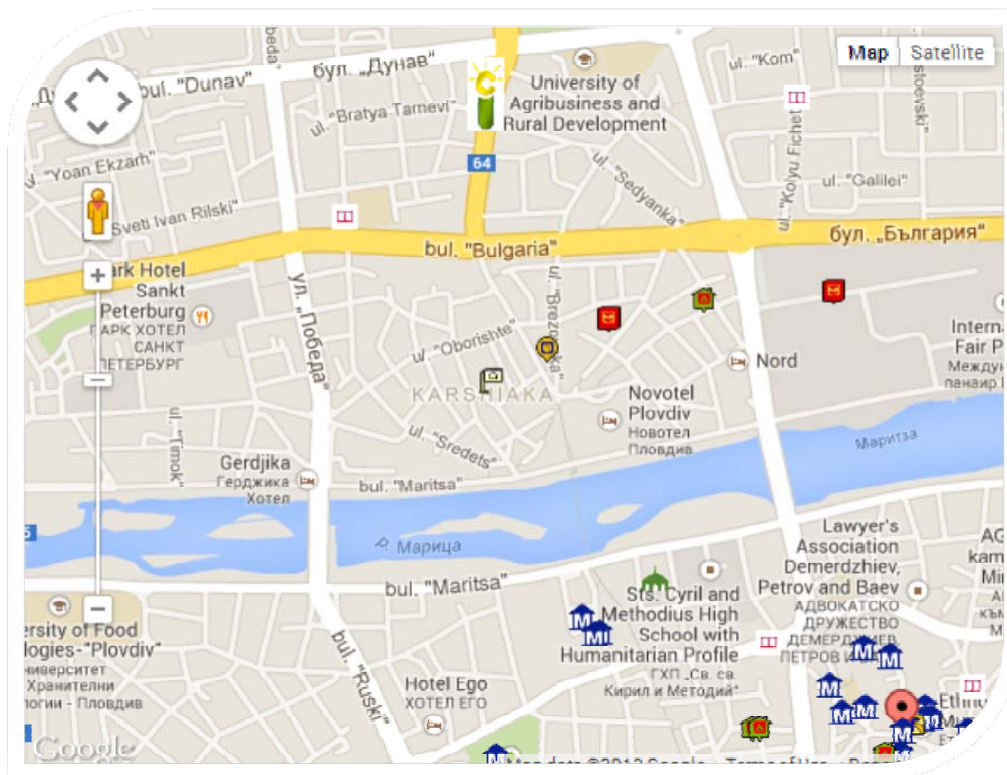
